You must complete ALL STEPS BELOW (register online and pay test center) by 1st November 2024 for window 1, 1st March 2025 for window 2 to reserve your seat. The Test Center will provide an AP Admission Ticket by 15th April 2025 as a confirmation that your seat is reserved.

IF YOU REGISTER ONLINE WITH THE COLLEGE BOARD BUT DO NOT PAY THE TEST CENTER, YOU WILL NOT BE ABLE TO TEST. IF YOU PAY BUT DO NOT COMPLETE ONLINE REGISTRATION, YOU WILL NOT BE ABLE TO TEST.

Click the **Join a Course or Exam** button. Make sure you have the six character join code.





- I acknowledge that I will be under 21 years old (born after May 31, 2004) at the time of taking any AP Exams in 2025
- I acknowledge that I will need to pay the test center and register online with the College Board by the stated deadline to complete my AP Exam registration and receive an Admission Ticket from the test center, or I will not be able to test.
- I acknowledge that I have read and agree to test center policies above, with respect to payment deadline, payment instructions, refunds and cancellations.
- I acknowledge that I will bring my own device with bluebook loaded to the test center on exam day, or I will not be able to test.
- I acknowledge that I will bring my Admission Ticket along with an original, VALID PASSPORT to the test center on exam day, or I will not be able to test.
- I acknowledge that if original, valid passport is not available, then I must have the Aadhaar in either original Letter format or the PVC version with hologram only (both received from UIDAI). No other Aadhaar versions will be accepted.
- Photocopies of the ID will not be accepted.
- Plan visa applications or ID renewals in advance to ensure you have valid ID
- I acknowledge that in order to take AP Exams, I am enrolled in or affiliated with a secondary school (high school) to take AP Exams. I meet at least one of the eligibility categories below:
- AP's Student eligibility: Students must be enrolled in or affiliated with a secondary school (high school) to take AP Exams. Students in any of the categories below are eligible to test:
 - Students actively enrolled in secondary school.
 - Secondary school-level students who are homeschooled, participate in independent study, or attend a virtual school.
 - Actively enrolled students who may be prepared to take an AP Exam prior to the ninth grade.
 - Recent secondary school graduates who need a specific AP Exam for university admission.
- If you recently graduated secondary school (typically within but not limited to 1-3 years after graduation) and need an AP Exam to apply for university, you do not need to contact the AP Program for permission to test in 2025. If you aren't sure if you're eligible to test, please contact your test center coordinator.

Additional testing policies

- You can take any or all of the 4 physics exams in the same year.
- You cannot retake an exam in the same year, although you may retake it in a subsequent year.
- You cannot take both Calculus AB and Calculus BC in the same year.
- You cannot take 2 exams scheduled at the same date and time. Decide which exam you wish to take first and then take the other exam during the next testing window.
- AP Exams are in-person digital/hybrid exams this year.
- You will have to carry your own charger and device and have completed sign in to <u>bluebook</u>.
- You are advised to complete practice tests on bluebook well before the exam.

IMPORTANT ID POLICY UPDATE

ID Policy for test centers in India:

Please plan any ID processing and applications in advance. Ensure you have acceptable ID to bring to the test site on exam day or you will not be able to test.

- AP-authorized test centers in India will only accept original, valid passport as ID for entry to the AP Exam administration.
- If original, valid passport is not available, then student must have the Aadhaar in either original Letter format or the PVC version with hologram only (both received from UIDAI). No other Aadhaar versions will be accepted.
- A sample of the letter version is shown on the left; it's the entire piece of paper and not just the card portion at the bottom. The PVC card sample is on the right.





7 RECEIVE ADMISSION TICKET FROM TEST CENTER

The test center will provide an admission ticket to you after they have ordered your exams. Admission Ticket will be provided no later than April, 2025. This ticket is confirmation your seat has been reserved. You will need this ticket on exam day, along with an original, valid Passport or you will not be able to test.
